

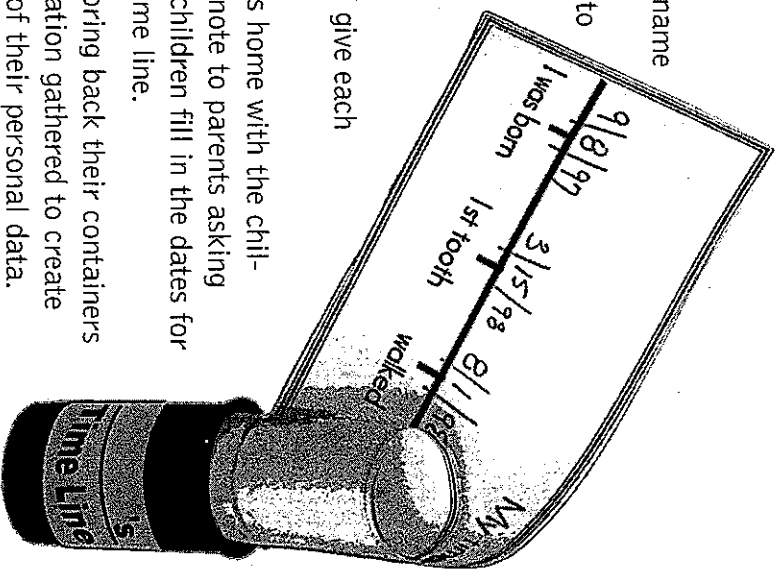
55 My Time Line

Materials

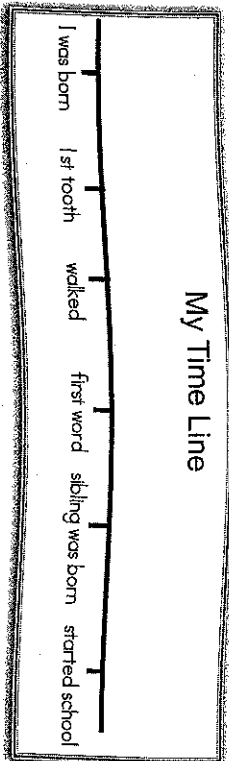
- Round black film container for each child
- Reproducible label: _____'s Time Line
- Time Line reproducibles (see page 134)

Directions

1. Write each child's name on a reproducible label and attach it to a container.
2. Photocopy the My Time Line reproducible, cut it apart, put one in each container, and give each child his container.
3. Send the containers home with the children, along with a note to parents asking them to help their children fill in the dates for the events on the time line.
3. Have the children bring back their containers and use the information gathered to create graphs and charts of their personal data.
