Attention: No spiral notebooks or book sacks are needed. There are no lockers. Students will use a zippered binder only. Loose leaf paper should be supplied all year.

1. Large, zippered 3-Ring Binder (Trapper Keeper Style - well-made to last the entire year)
2. Pack of dividers for binder (Label them - Math, Science, Language, History, Reading)
3. 3 Composition Books
4. **Either** - Mechanical pencils with #2 lead **or** regular #2 pencils (Students will need extra lead/regular pencils as the year progresses.)
5. 1 small pencil sharpener (**one that catches shavings**). There are no pencil sharpeners in the classrooms.
6. Blue or Black pens (This will be the only color allowed for assignments.)
7. 1 8-pack of colored pencils **or** 1 24-pack of Crayola colors
The following items will be collected by the teacher at the beginning of the year and stored. They will be distributed as needed.
8. 2 Dry Erase Markers
9. 2 boxes of Kleenex and 2 rolls of paper towels (solid white if possible)
10. 4 packs of 100 "3x5" **color** index cards (ruled)
11. Small box of quart size ziplock bags
12. 2 large boxes of disinfectant wipes

ABSOLUTELY no toys, gel pens or white-out allowed. If students bring these items to school, they will be confiscated and thrown away.

Also, the **ONLY** outerwear that a student may wear inside the classroom is stipulated in the TPSS dress code policy. Student Progress Center

Parents of children in the Tangipahoa Parish School System have access to a web application called the Student Progress Center (formerly known as "Parent Command Center") that will provide them with current student information online. The purpose of the online system is to allow parents "a safe and secure means (that protects the data and ensures privacy) to review their child's class assignments, grades, attendance records, discipline, transcripts, fees, and other information in order to monitor their child's progress in school. Current grades are posted for every subject a student takes. Once teachers enter test and assignment grades, the student's average is shown to allow parents the ability to monitor progress in each subject. The School System is committed to including parents in the educational process, and this is one way to keep parents connected. 8TH GRADE POLICIES
