<b>Title:</b>	<b>Name that Letter</b>
Grade Levels:	Pre-Kindergarten
Curriculum Areas:	☞ CC PK Reading
Measurable Objectives:	☞ TSW identify the letters of the alphabet.
LA Content Standards/GLE's:	☞ Demonstrate understanding of alphabetic principle by identifying at least eight uppercase or lowercase letters, focusing on those in the student's name (PK-LL-L3) (ELA-1-E1) ☞ Demonstrate consistent top-to-bottom formation for letters or letter-like forms (PK-LL-W2) (ELA-3-E1)

Procedures:	☞ <b>Modeling:</b> TTW show students several letters and tell students their name. ☞ <b>Guided Practice:</b> TTW use the Literacy Center website to introduce letters and their names and show how letters are formed. This activity can be done over several days before moving on to the independent practice. ☞ <b>Independent Practice:</b> TSW visit the rotating computer station to identify the letters and practice letter formation. ☞ <b>Review:</b> TTW hold up letter flash cards and have students name them. ☞ <b>Closure:</b> TTW have students name the letters in their own name and use the Kid Pix Letter Stamps to create their name.

Assessment:	☞ TO, SP, student correctly names letters in their own name
