Procedures:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> TTW introduce the lesson with a model of the circle book. The information on the mobile would be i-Safe and the new kind of virus. TTW explain that today the students are going to make circle book as we learn about computer viruses. Begin by explaining about i-Safe and their mission ot help students stay safe when using the computer and the internet. TTW dialog with the students to complete the circle book. TTW ask questions as a guide for the students. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Who can tell me what Cyberspace is, and how can we get there? 2. How do we communicate with other people in cyberspace? 3. Did you know that a computer can get sick just like you can? 4. Does anyone know what a virus is? 5. How can people catch a virus, and what happens when they do? 6. Do you know how a computer gets a virus? 7. What do you think it means when I say, 'the virus hides'? 8. What do you think about someone who would send a hidden virus to another person's computer in an email? 9. Would they be good citizens? 10. How would you keep viruses away from your computer? After students have completed their circle books, demonstrate the proper way to glue the pages together to create the circle book mobile. TSW share their mobiles with the class.
