



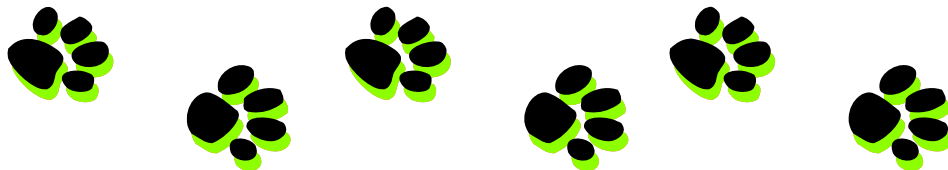

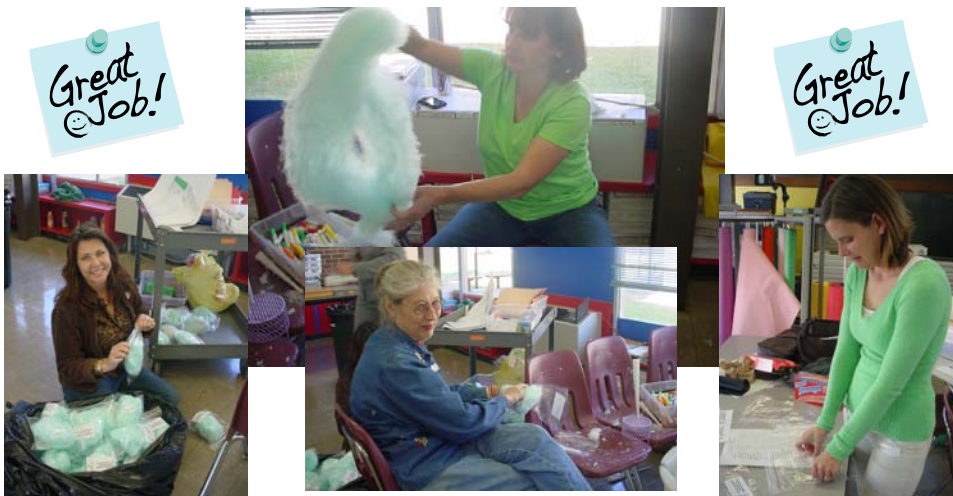
Perrin ELC Supports Relay for Life
