


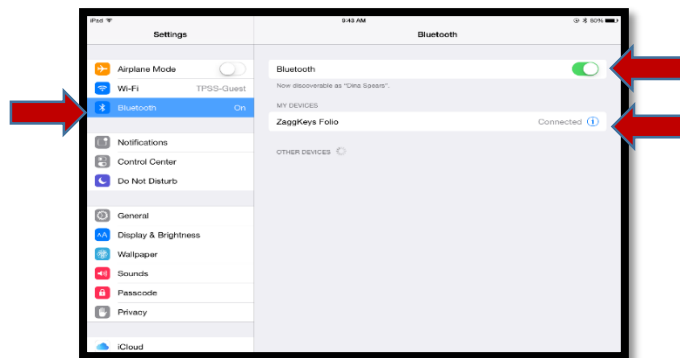
Tips for using the ZAGG Folio Bluetooth Keyboard

The controls for the keyboard are on the right side. There is a charging port, a Power on/off switch and a Bluetooth “Connect” button.

1. Make sure you charge the keyboard regularly. Especially after use.
2. Slide the Power slider down to turn on the keyboard.
3. Press the Connect button to the left of the Power slider to connect the keyboard.

If the keyboard is still not connected, make sure the Bluetooth setting is “On”. To do this:

1. Tap the “Settings” Icon on the iPad 
2. Tap “Bluetooth”. If it is already on, tap the slider to turn it off, then tap it to turn it back on. This will reset the connection.
3. If you do not see ZaggKeys Folio, press the “Connect” button on the side of the keyboard. Once you see the keyboard on the screen, tap it to connect. You should see “Connected” by the keyboard name.



To check keyboard battery, press the Battery key on the bottom left of the keyboard. The LED light on the right will flash in one of three ways:

1. Three green flashes indicate 50% or more battery life remaining.
2. Three yellow flashes indicate between 25%-49% battery life remaining.
3. Three red flashes indicate less than 25% battery life remaining. When your Folio reaches critical battery level, the red light will flash once every five minutes.
