

## POULTRY AND RABBIT DIVISION

### Rules and regulations:

1. Participation is open to all ages
2. All entries must be the property of exhibitors, otherwise all premiums will be forfeited.
3. No person may enter more than one exhibit of the same variety.
4. Those exhibiting poultry and/or rabbits will do so at their own risk. All animals will be given care and attention. Precautions will be taken to return the animals in good shape to owners.
5. Any animals showing symptoms of disease will be excluded from the exhibit removed from the grounds and returned to the owners.
6. Poultry may be entered as single cock, hen, cockerel, pullet, old trio, and young trio.
7. Poultry competing in single cannot compete in trio.
8. All entries must preregister by 5 p.m. Tuesday, September 29, 2015 at the Poultry and Rabbit Building on the fairgrounds in Amite. Premiums will not be awarded to late entries.
9. Exhibits must be brought to the Fair's Poultry and Rabbit Building from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Tuesday, September 29, 2015 and until 9:30 a.m. Wednesday, September 30, 2015 (if space allows for more entries). All exhibits must be in place and ready for judging by 9:30 a.m. Wednesday, September 30, 2015.
10. No exhibit can be moved before 1 p.m. Sunday, October 4, 2015.
11. Any other matter not covered by specific rules, is the decision of the poultry/rabbit committee.
12. Bring proper containers for water and feed. Bowls will NOT be allowed as the animals spill them over and then have nothing to eat or drink for that day. Additionally, you must bring enough feed for your animal for the entire week. Someone from the fair will refill the waterers and feeders, but will NOT supply the feed.
13. Owner may take ribbon off the cage.

Exhibits will be judged by comparison methods. The American Standard of perfection will be the guide of the judges in awarding premiums, the judges will award no premiums to any unworthy specimen. The following definitions will apply to all exhibits in poultry and rabbit divisions.

Cock – a male bird twelve (12) months or older

Hen – a female bird twelve (12) months or older

Cockerel – a male bird less than twelve (12) months old

Pullet – a female bird less than twelve (12) months old

Young Trio – a cockerel and two pullets, same variety

Old Trio – a cock and two hens, same variety

Rabbit – any breed.

Poultry premiums will be awarded as follows:

Single/Trio – 1<sup>st</sup> \$3.00 – 2<sup>nd</sup> \$2.00 – 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$1.00

Pair (Ducks, Geese) 1<sup>st</sup> - \$3.00– 2<sup>nd</sup>- \$2.00 - 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$1.00

Single (Turkeys) 1<sup>st</sup> - \$3.00 – 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$2.00 – 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$1.00
