

PARENT DROP-OFF LINE PROCEDURES

****Your child's safety is our primary concern.****

- 1. When you arrive on campus, please continue to drive passed the main entrance of the school to the speed bumps. We want students to exit the vehicles in waves of eight to ten cars at one time. If everyone pulls up to the front, then students can all unload at one time, and cars in the left lane will not have to keep stopping and waiting for students to cross. *This is a safer and faster method of unloading in the morning.***
- 2. *DO NOT PARK ON THE GRASS OR ON THE SIDE OF THE ENTRANCE.***
- 3. Instruct students to walk in front of your vehicle when exiting.**
- 4. Please do not switch drivers in the traffic line. If you must do this, then drive to the parking spaces passed the drop-off entrance and pull in. When the line stops to unload, then you may pull out and exit.**
- 5. Please be attentive to what is happening in the line. When you continue to talk to your child out of the window, or if you watch your child walk into the building, you are backing up the traffic line.**
- 6. Do not drop students off at the back of the line. This causes the cars to back up onto the highway, and it is unsafe for students. Only drop-off students between the painted yellow lines by each of the speed bumps.**
- 7. Do not drop students off at the gate by the entrance to the new wing, and do not enter the student parking lot. This is a safety hazard, and it is against campus traffic policy.**
- 8. Do not enter campus from the Ridgell Road entrance and drive to the parent drop off line. The Hwy. 22 entrance to the student parking lot is one-way in the morning to allow students and teachers safe entrance into the parking lot.**
