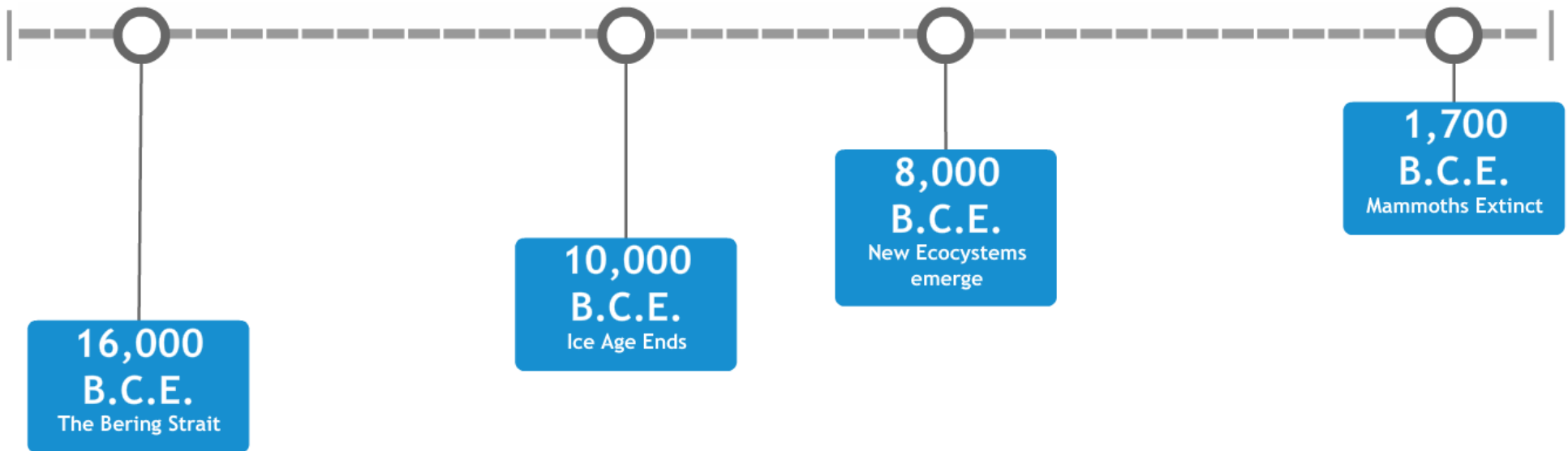

Items:

- 16,000 B.C.E.
The Bering Strait land bridge formed during the Ice Age.
- 10,000 B.C.E.
A cold period marked by episodes of extensive glaciation alternating with episodes of relative warmth.
- 8,000 B.C.E.
During this period much of the land that was once tundra has warmed and become other types of ecosystems.
- 1,700 B.C.E.
During the end of the Ice Age all mammoths become extinct due to the climate change.
